



## Basketball Competition Basic Rules

1. Games will begin at the time stated in the schedule. At 10 minutes past the start time the game will be determined a forfeit.
2. A team must be able to provide four (4) players by the forfeit starting time. Once the fifth player arrives he may be substituted into the game immediately without penalty.
3. A final score of 50-0 will be recorded for all forfeits.
4. Four players are required to start a game.
5. All games will consist of two (2) ten (10) minute halves with one (1) minutes between each half.
6. The clock will stop on the referee's whistle ONLY in the last TWO (2) minutes of the second half. It will also stop the last ONE (1) minute of any overtime period.
7. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation, a three (3) minute overtime period will be played.
8. All substitutes must report to the scorers table before they may enter a game. Players may substitute only when the clock stops or on a dead ball.
9. Each team will be given TWO (2) 1-minute TIME OUTS PER game. In the event of an overtime period each team will be given one additional 30 second time out.
10. Teams will shoot two shots free throw throughout the game. Technical fouls will consist of two (2) shots per technical.
11. Players' personal fouls will not be recorded/counted, however serious flagrant fouls e.g. unnecessary roughness and fighting will result in ejection from game upon the discretion of referees.
12. Players may attempt to rebound the ball on foul shots once the ball has left the shooters hand.
13. The three (3) point basket will be in effect where the gym floor is appropriately marked.
14. Dunking is allowed. If at any time unnecessary grabbing of the rim occurs; this includes warm-ups; a technical foul will be assessed and a warning given to both teams. A second occurrence by either team will result in a technical foul as well as the player being ejected for the remainder of that game.
15. The top TWO (2) teams of each group will advance to the semi-finals.
16. In the event the results ended with W/L ties of teams in group matches, the teams to advance to semi-finals will be determined by points scored in matches. If point-tallies remained tie as well, then a sudden death 7-minutes match will be played to determine the winners to advance.
